At the upcoming fall meeting, the Steering Committee is proposing changes to two pieces of the Parent's Association Constitution. The proposed is as follows: Under #7: Currently reads that the steering committee is made up of 3 men, 3 women and a board representative. Proposed update would change language to say 2 men, 2 women and a board representative. Under #10: Currently reads that the term of service for committee is 3 years. Proposed update would be for 2 years, as with a committee of 4, a 3-year term isn't really navigable.
