Qualifications:

- 1. Must hold a special education degree.
- 2. Must hold a current Wisconsin or alternative teaching license.
- 3. Must understand special education policy and procedures (IEP, ISP, etc.).

Job Summary:

Provide students with appropriate learning activities and experiences designed to fulfill their potential for intellectual, spiritual, emotional, physical, and social growth; enable students to develop competencies and skills to function successfully.

Basic Responsibilities:

- 1. Collaborate with General Education Teachers and other professionals concerning students who are at risk in the learning environment.
- 2. Remediate learning deficits through direct instruction with students.
- 3. Evaluate skills and neurodevelopmental patterns to meet the needs of the students.
- 4. Coordinate ISP's, updating them annually or as needed.
- 5. Design and deliver direct instruction appropriate to the neurodevelopmental and academic needs of students, including home and life skills if needed.
- 6. Advise General Education Staff concerning effective teaching strategies, materials, and curriculum relative to assessment results.
- 7. Participate in parent meetings during scheduled school conferences (as needed).
- 8. Maintain records of students' objectives and student progress.
- 9. Keep the school administrator informed of specific student, program, and General Education Staff concerns.
